A budget workshop was held by the Town Board of the Town of Greenville on October 13th, 2025 at 6:00pm at Pioneer Hall.

The purpose of this meeting was to review the tentative budget with the adjustments made since the first budget workshop. The following discussions were had:

- Workers Comp projected to have a savings of 50% from last year.
- Refuse cost increase was due to hauling excess of tires from Highway Department.
- Water & Sewer management increase of 3% for North Dome.

New Business

Teamsters Agreement – Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to ratify the teamster agreement as presented for 1/1/2026-12/31/2028. Carried 4 ayes

Sole Assessor Resolution – The following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Greenville appointed Peter Hotaling Interim Sole Assessor for six months (August 18, 2025-February 18, 2026)
