Beautification – Bill VonAtzingen gave a verbal report highlighting that the duck auction was successful, Prevost Hall bell tower repairs are in progress, and that he is working with Greenville Rotary to get the trees set up at Veteran’s Park.

District #4 Legislator – Greg Davis gave a verbal report on the County’s current projects and legislation. No motions made.

New Business

Shoulder Roller– Highway Superintendent Mike Dudley reported that there is a should roller on Auctions International located in Woodstock. They usually run for around \$70k. The equipment used to do shoulders currently is dangerous and purchasing this shoulder roller would increase safety. The Town does not currently have a machine that would operate it. The action closes on November 20th. *Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to bid on the shoulder roller on Auctions International for up to \$25k. Carried 4 ayes.*

Gas & Diesel Suppliers – *Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman Macko to piggyback off of the Greene County gas, fuel oil and diesel bid and switch to Bottini. Carried 4 ayes*

Used Crew Cab Dump Truck – *Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to purchase a used crew cab dump truck for \$3,950. Carried 4 ayes*

Town Park Drive Resolution – *The following resolutions was adopted*

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Greenville has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to adopt Greenville Town Park Road as an official Town Highway and to add same to the Town’s Highway Inventory, and

WHEREAS, the NYSDOT previously added said road to the Town inventory but did not include the road’s full length; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to notify NYSDOT of such adoption and of the full length of the said road in accordance with that agency’s requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Greenville hereby 1) authorizes the Town Supervisor or his designee to complete and file the NYSDOT Local Highway Inventory New Or Extended Road Template for the above stated purpose; 2) acknowledges that the Town has the legal responsibility for the said road; 3) acknowledges its responsibility for the operation and maintenance of said road as a public road; 4) acknowledges that such shall be open to the public without restriction; and 5) the description of the road is “That Roadway commencing at it’s intersection with NYS Route 32 on the westerly side thereof and located approximately one tenth of a mile south of Route 32 and Irving Road and proceeding 0.32 miles in a generally westerly direction to its end.”
