New Business

Schedule Organizational Meeting– *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to schedule the Organizational Meeting on January 2, 2026 at 5:00pm at Pioneer Hall. Carried 4 ayes*

Snow Removal Publication – *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to publish an advertisement in the Town’s official newspaper as follows: Effective November 15th, 2025 to April 15th, 2026 Pursuant to Section 1660, Subdivision 8 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, the Town Superintendent of Highways is authorized to have any vehicle parked or abandoned on Town Highways during snow storms or other public emergencies where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic and or for the removal of snow removed at the vehicle owner’s expense. The Town of Greenville will not be held responsible or any damage incurred during removal or storage of said vehicle. Also under Section 1660, Subdivision 8 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York there is to be no discarding of snow on any Highway or Public Roads. Carried 4 ayes*

Tobacco Free Workshop – *Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to schedule a special meeting to hold a workshop from 6:00-7:00 on Feb 16, 2026 at Pioneer Hall. Carried 4 ayes*

Local Law Adoption – *Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to adopt Local Law #6 of 2025 Modifying Zoning and Solar Law. Carried 4 ayes*

3 Year PERMA option – *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to sign a three year contract with PERMA as you can save an addition 5% if accident ratings stay low. Carried 4 ayes*

Justice Records – tabled until Organizational Meeting – report not yet received.

Columbia-Greene Humane Society – *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to sign the 2026 Columbia-Greene Humane Society engagement. Carried 4 ayes*

Building Department Computer & Program purchase – Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman to approve the quote received from Edmunds Govtech for \$1650 to purchase new computer and program for the new Code Enforcement Officer and an additional \$1100 to replace a computer for the current Code Enforcement Officer. Carried 4 ayes

Drug testing/EAP agreement – Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to approve the 2026 EAP agreement with Westchester Med. Carried 4 ayes
