**Schedule Workshop**– *Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to schedule a special meeting for a workshop on tobacco free policies on February 16, 2026 from 6:00pm-6:45pm at Pioneer Hall. Carried 5 ayes*

**Bagged Garbage Rates** – The Board discussed the increased tipping fees, rates at neighboring town’s recycling centers, as well as, the Recycling Center requiring some upgrades/facelift. *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bensen to schedule a Public Hearing on February 16, 2026 from 6:45pm-7:00pm to discuss increasing the bagged garbage rates at the Town recycling center. Carried 5 ayes*

**Roof Bids**– *Councilman Bensen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to solicit bids/estimates for the replacement of the roof of the highway building, the pioneer hall meeting room, above the sheriff’s entry and the records room roofs, to be received no later than February 16, 2026 at 7:00pm. **Organizational Amendments** – *The following resolution was offered:*

**WHEREAS** the Town of Greenville Town Board held its organizational meeting on January 2, 2026 and made certain resolutions with respect there too; and

**WHEREAS** the Town of Greenville Town Board now wishes to make certain amendments to some of those resolutions.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**

That the Town board of the Town of Greenville hereby makes the following amendments to the organizational meeting minutes and resolutions:

30#: that Jessica Lewis be appointed to sit with the Board of Assessment Review for \$50/session; member terms remain through September of each year, each with \$400 annual stipend. Member terms are as follows: Gerard Smith 10/1/2023-9/30/2028, Douglas Overbaugh 10/01/2024-9/30/2029, Alexis Aloisi 10/1/2025-9/30/2030, Lise Vanderpyle 1/19/2026-9/30/2028 and Stephen Jackson 1/2/2024-9/30/2028

#39: that the following people be appointed to the Greenville Planning Board for a 5 year term: Debbie Danner (2030), Ken Elsbree (2027), Orloff Bear (2028), William Bardel (2030); and that Donald Teator be appointed Chair (2026) and that an annual stipend of \$500 per member or alternate and \$600 for the Chair shall be paid in December. Stephen Jay Goodman is appointed as Alternate Member (2026). Regular attendance is an expectation for all members, including alternates

#41: that the members of the Zoning Board of Appeals are as follows: Tom Vance (Chair) 1/1/26-12/31/2030, John Ingalls (Deputy Chair) 1/1/2025-12/31/2029, Steven Jackson 1/2/2025-12/31/2029, Sandy Garden 1/1/2023-12/31/2027, Judith Ann Elliott-Brown 1/1/2024-1/1/2028, Art Marini and Tom Briggs as Alternates for 1/1/2026-12/31/2026, and that an annual stipend of \$400 per chair and co-chair and an annual stipend of \$300 per member or alternate shall be paid in December. Regular attendance is an expectation for all members, including alternates.

Resolution offered by Councilman Bensen, seconded by Councilman Bear, and carried.

**Hometown Heroes Banners** – The Board discussed a suggestion that was received to put up Hometown Hero banners through town. Discussion was tabled until more information could be gathered.
